Creating a Database

Defining the Skill

A database is a collection of information, or data, that is organized so that you can find and retrieve information on a certain topic quickly and easily. Once you set up a database on the computer, you can search for specific information without going through the entire database. Learning how to use a database will help you to create your own.

▶▶ Applying the Skill

The screen below shows a database for the history of settlement in Melanesia. Use the strategies listed below to help you understand and use the database.


How to Create a Database

Strategy • Read the title to identify the topic of the database. In this title, the most important words, or keywords, are "history," "settlement," and "Melanesia." These keywords were used to begin the research for this database.

Strategy 2 Identify the kind of data you need to enter in your database. These will become the column headings of your database. In this case, the key words "country," "settlement," "colonization," and "independence" were chosen to focus the research.

Strategy 3 Identify the entries included under each heading.

Strategy 4 Use the database to help you find information quickly. For example, if this database were on a computer, you could search for "United Kingdom" to find out which of these countries were colonized by the United Kingdom.
